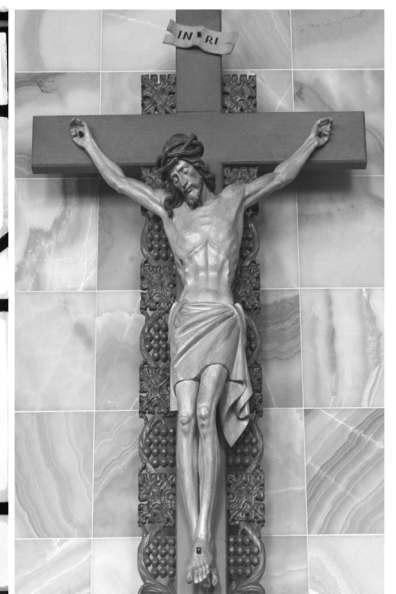
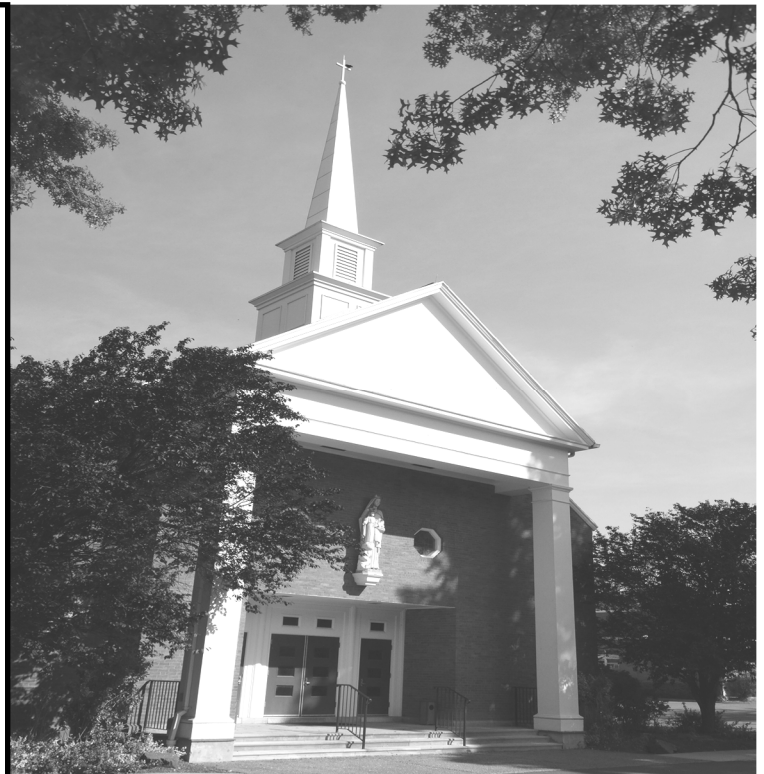

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION


In this country, we don't name our churches "The Fourth Avenue Catholic Church," but rather seek a patron saint or mystery of faith. We inherit this tradition from an old Roman custom via medieval England. Interestingly, that has not been the practice elsewhere, and parishes abroad often do carry just the name of the neighborhood. In Ireland, the Roman (English) practices didn't take hold, and so churches are known simply by the street they are on, or by a nickname. Saint Francis of Assisi in Dublin is often called "Adam and Eve" after a pub in the same street. The pub sign is an interesting carving of our first parents, so they become patrons by default.

Increasingly in the United States, we are seeing a familiar European pattern emerge when a few churches, each bearing the name of a patron saint or mystery, are gathered into one parish that bears a different name. Thus, we might hear of a parish of "Midvalley City" comprised of Saint Mary, Saint Francis, and Saint Ursula churches. Once a church has been consecrated, its name may not normally be changed. Therefore, when parishes are merged, a new name is given to the parish, which may or may not be that of a heavenly patron, but the church buildings retain their names. In the process, we have lost sight of some worthy patrons of old, but have also seen new parishes open dedicated to twentieth-century saints like Edith Stein, Katharine Drexel, and Mother Teresa.

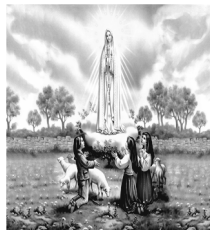

WHAT IS THE CATHOLIC CHARISMATIC RENEWAL?



Pope St. John XXIII, in his prayer for the Second Vatican Council, prayed for God to “Renew your wonders in this our day as by a new Pentecost”. The Council spoke in surprising ways about the Holy Spirit. The popes since the Second Vatican Council have called the Church to a greater awareness of the importance of the Holy Spirit. A current of grace sprang up after the Second Vatican Council that came to be known as the Catholic Charismatic Renewal. Charisms are manifestations of the Spirit, showing forth and demonstrating the presence of the Holy

Spirit. “To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit” (1Cor. 12:7). They mediate God’s love, presence, power, and guidance. When a charism is active in a person, people see not only that individual’s act of service, but experience God reaching out to them through that person. The charismatic dimension of the Church has existed in the Church since the coming of Jesus and the out pouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

The Charismatic renewal refers to the totality of the workings of the Holy Spirit in our day traceable to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit we call “baptism in the Holy Spirit”. There are a variety of callings and graces in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. These include, among others, youth ministry, healing ministry, prayer groups, intercession ministry and evangelization. We are taught that charismatic gifts are to be received with thanksgiving and consolation, for they are exceedingly suitable and useful for the needs of the Church. The various charismatic groups and ministries are dedicated to the “fostering of baptism in the Holy Spirit, the exercise of charisms and a renewal of the full role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church. Pope Francis said that the Charismatic Renewal is part of a “current of grace” initiated by the Holy Spirit for the whole Church. Source material: Celebrating a Charismatic Jubilee by Fr. 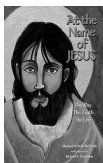
