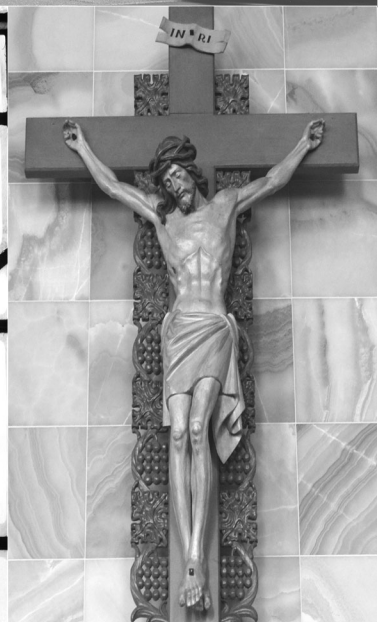

“We are Parts of the Whole” Deacon Frank

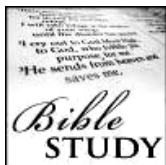
These are the words of St Paul in 1 Corinthians Chapter 12. What does this mean? We often think that we are islands unto ourselves. Me against the world. St Paul however tells us many times in his writings that we are not simply ourselves but part of each other. We are all created by God not as independent beings but interconnected beings. Christianity is not for the “rugged individualist”. Christians are dependent on each other. We are individually parts of the body of Christ. Jesus is the perfect manifestation of God in human form. You and I through Jesus’ death and Resurrection form a piece of that manifestation. We are made in the “image and likeness of God” as the catechism says. Imperfect as we are, we need each other to complete the perfection. Your talents assist me in achieving my talents which God has given me. I “pay it forward” to assist someone else to achieve their fullness of creation.

Christ, in His Resurrection, lives through you and I. We cannot ignore the talents that God has given us no matter what age we are or what our financial condition. Every person is created by God for a purpose. There are no wasted people. Even the “poorest of the poor” as St Teresa of Calcutta called them have a purpose and a reason for God creating them. There is something to be shared by all of us in this life. Love and kindness are gifts to give that cost us nothing. A smile to an unknown person we see can be worth much when it is given to someone who is fighting off the challenges of life. The next time you think that we are alone remember St Paul’s words. Christ lives in each one of us. The following story printed in Reader’s Digest makes the point:

“When the supermarket clerk tallied up my groceries, I was \$12 over what I had on me. I began to remove items from the bags, when another shopper handed me a \$20 bill. “Please don’t put yourself out,” I told him. “Let me tell you a story,” he said. “My mother is in the hospital with cancer. I visit her every day and bring her flowers. I went this morning, and she got mad at me for spending my money on more flowers. She demanded that I do something else with that money. So, here, please accept this. It is my mother’s flowers.”

Don’t be afraid to share yourself with others. Be part of God’s goodness and love.



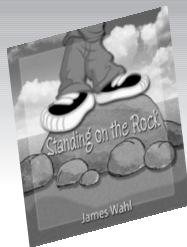

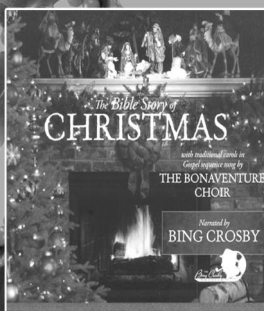
