ADVENT AS THE TIME FOR PREPARATION AND PLANNING – Deacon Frank

In exactly one month we will be starting a new calendar year. 2018 will be gone and we will ring in 2019 with all the fanfare we are accustomed to. Soon after the New Year's Eve Parties and the well wishes many of us in our silent moments will take some time to assess our lives and to try to make sense of where we've been and where we are going. We make promises to ourselves to change, "this year will be different". Diet, and exercise are the most common of these changes. Every year though is the same it seems, we dream, we promise, we plan, and we fail. Perhaps our plans are too ambitious. We need to start small and take the process one step at a time. Perhaps eliminating late night snacks and taking walks would be a good start.
