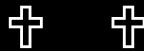

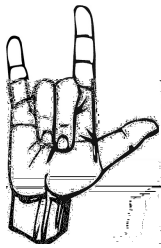

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION



In recent years, there has been remarkable progress in drawing persons with disabilities into full celebration. Now it is generally accepted that worship places need accommodations such as ramps or elevators, large-print materials for those who are sight-impaired, and perhaps even an assisted hearing system or signing in American Sign Language. American Sign Language is not merely English translated into movement, but a distinct language with its own grammar, syntax (word order), and vocabulary. For this reason, the American Catholic bishops have approved American Sign Language (ASL) as an official language of the liturgy.

Celebrating liturgy in our own language (the vernacular) means that liturgy must be accessible to all languages and cultures. The fact that Mass is celebrated this weekend in some places in total silence, but with the full participation of deaf people praising God in the movements of their hands, and sometimes even with a priest who is deaf, is nothing less than the Church being faithful to the image of Jesus, who made the deaf hear and the mute speak. Remember too that deafness is an invisible disability, and that there may well be people in your parish who are quietly yearning for Mass to be signed for them in ASL.

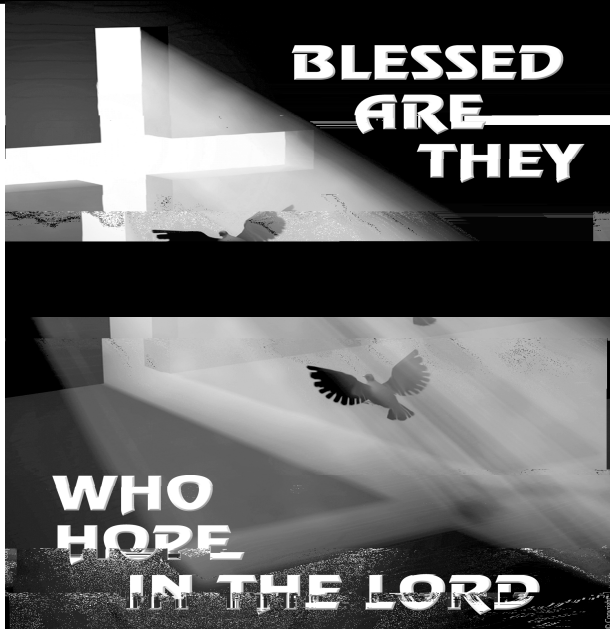

**Stop the Lies Against CT Pregnancy Resource Centers
Oppose HB 7070**

On Monday, February 11, 2019, the Public Health Committee of the Connecticut General Assembly held a public hearing on House Bill 7070: An Act Concerning Deceptive Advertising Practices of Limited Services Pregnancy Centers.

Although the title of the legislation implies that it targets false advertising, this bill limits the free speech rights of pro-life pregnancy resource centers (PRCs).

Proponents believe that this is a better way to achieve their goal in light of the Supreme Court's recent decision in *NIFLA v. Becerra*.

HB 7070 has been drafted at the behest of and with the assistance of pro-abortion organizations, such as NARAL and Planned Parenthood.

This malicious effort is part of a national campaign to harass, penalize, and eventually shutdown PRCs. The Connecticut Catholic Public Affairs Conference strongly opposes this proposed legislation and urges you to help us defeat HB 7070.

Some Background:

NARAL has launched a national campaign to discredit and eventually shutdown organizations that assist thousands of pregnant women a year in our state, and across the nation, who choose to keep their unborn children and reject the alternative of abortion.

Connecticut PRCs provide women in our state facing an unplanned pregnancy a true "choice".

Women are treated with compassion and concern from the first moment of contact with a PRC. A woman learns that, if she decides to keep her baby, that the PRC is there to help her with emotional and material support. She will not be alone. If she leaves the PRC and decides to abort her baby that also is her choice.

NARAL uses unsubstantiated facts and hearsay to make PRCs appear deceitful and manipulative toward women seeking guidance and assistance. The exact opposite is true.

NARAL has a difficult time citing any actual complaints by clients. This is because PRCs in Connecticut treat their clients with compassion, kindness and openness.

The only ones complaining about PRCs are those who oppose their position on abortion, such as NARAL and Planned Parenthood, not the clients served.

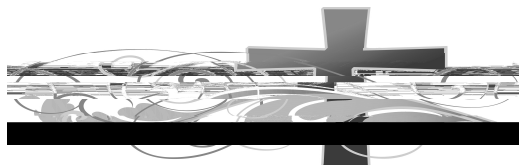

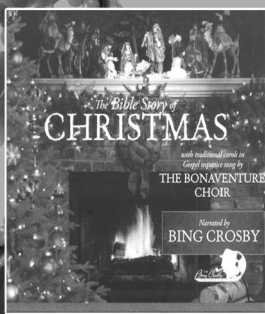


