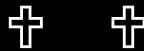

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Hollywood has given us an image of Moses slipping off his shoes before a burning bush. God has just called Moses by name, and so that Moses doesn't miss the meaning of this breakthrough in human history, God requires that all barriers to the experience be eliminated. If you've ever tried to maneuver barefoot across hot sand, or pick your way along a rocky beach, you know how sensitive feet can be.

Within the Church, there are religious orders with a custom of going barefoot, not merely to show poverty, but to be an outward sign of a desire for connection with creation, a desire to go through life alert to what God is doing. In early days, when reconciliation was a once-in-a-lifetime possibility, penitents often went barefoot for a long period of time as a sign of their conversion. Even today, people follow an ancient practice of slipping off their shoes to walk in the procession to the cross on Good Friday. It is striking that the first use of our newly scrubbed feet from Holy Thursday night is to walk resolutely in the footsteps of Christ to the cross

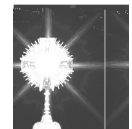

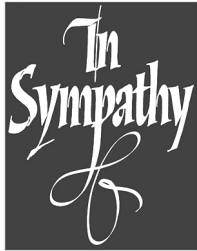

SOUP SUPPERS Triple Nourishment?

Koinonia (pronounced “coin-o-nee’-ah) is the Greek word for community/fellowship – it appears in the Greek version of the New Testament 19 times and it is how early Christians stuck together through a difficult time in Christian history.

Early Christian communities had no churches*; they met in peoples’ houses to pray and receive the Eucharist, quite hidden from the public, because they could be put to death for practicing the new religion. Our Soup Suppers hark back, in some ways, to those early Christian gatherings. We use a bigger “house” and of course are now free to celebrate our faith publicly. There is a joy in community, listening to wisdom, sharing food.

With community we nourish our hearts, being in the company of like-minded congregation members, sharing life stories. Here is an opportunity to experience Koinonia. Then we nourish our bodies with soup made with loving generosity and care. And then, we nourish our minds with the wisdom offered from our speakers. Speakers from our congregation who have spent considerable thought and time, gathering and researching scripture, organizing materials, writing, editing and practicing their words, worrying about their deliverance, trying to make it good for us, all for the purpose of sharing some wisdom and brightening our experience of Koinonia.

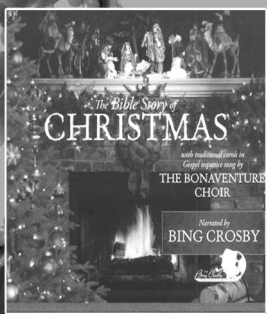
