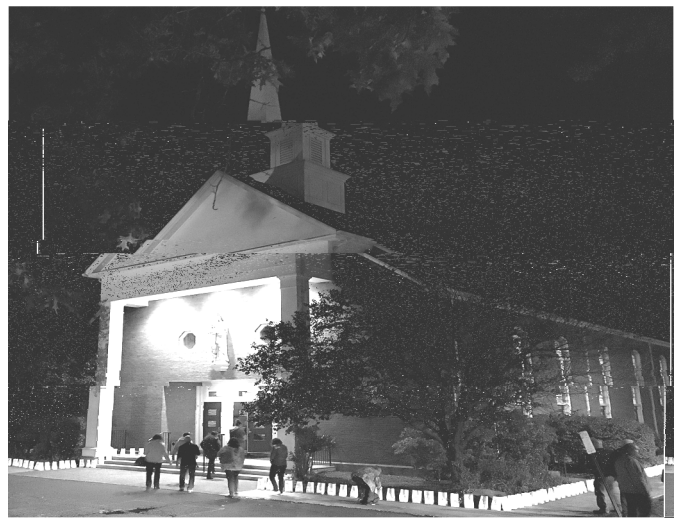

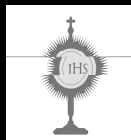

ABOUT THE SISTERS: Sr. Denise and Sr. Gertrude are preparing for their new home as Sr. Margaret settles into hers. Last week, Sr. Margaret moved to Braemar at Medford in Long Island along with her puppets and a few penguins. Sr. Denise has been living in the convent for almost 50 years so moving will be a somewhat new experience for her. She and Sr. Gertrude are in the process of securing an apartment not far from our future location on Captain Thomas Blvd. “The parishioners’ responses to our move have been heart-warming,” she said. “I can’t tell you how many people recommended apartments or offered prayers and concern for us. It is truly touching.” She said she will miss her “home... a little bit of heaven” at the convent but is so happy that she can remain in our parish community. “It’s really been a beautiful journey all these years,” Sr. Denise added, “I’m looking forward to continuing to be active at Our Lady of Victory and doing what I’ve always done here.”

While Sr. Denise is a little nervous about living in an apartment, Sr. Gertrude is looking forward to it – somewhat: “I’m unhappy about moving, but not miserable,” she laughed. “I look forward to meeting new people in our building and having neighbors close by.” In the past, she’s enjoyed living in a place where she can meet others right outside her door. She is also looking forward to staying active in ministry at Our Lady of Victory. “This is my home parish,” she said, “I wasn’t surprised by the concern and love parishioners have shown us, but I admit I am overwhelmed by it. Emergency Calls for a Priest



Too often we get called for the Sacrament of the Sick when someone has become unconscious and is very close to death. Far better to call the priest earlier: The sick person can be part of the sacramental moment, and Father has time to get there. **IMPORTANT NOTE** : sometimes Father is not available for immediate response, so please, if there is someone at home is elderly and failing, or battling cancer, call us earlier rather than later so we can give appropriate pastoral service to your loved one.

CATHOLIC CHURCH ANNULMENTS

Many Catholics have asked the following questions about the Church's position on divorce, annulments, and marriage:

- ☐ "Can a divorced person receive Communion?"
- ☐ "Can a divorced person marry in the Catholic Church?"
- ☐ "Why might a non-Catholic consider or need an Annulment?"
- ☐ "Does a divorced person need an annulment when the marriage was performed only by a Justice of the Peace?"

Often these questions and others have been met with misleading, misguided and sometimes wrong responses. Perhaps you, a family member or a friend needs sound, clear information.

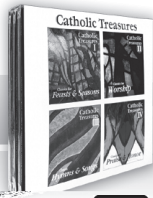
