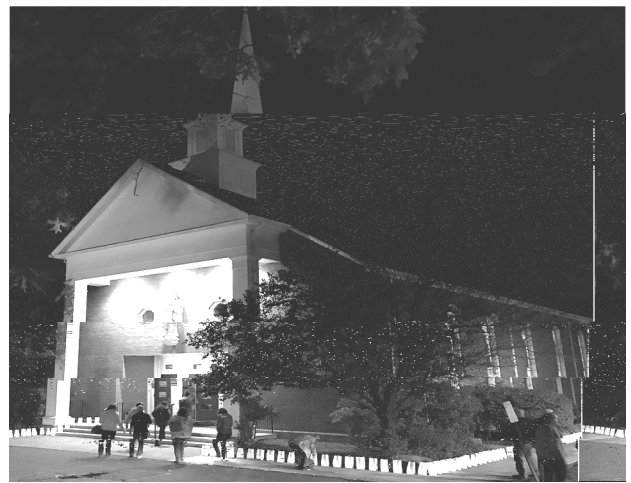

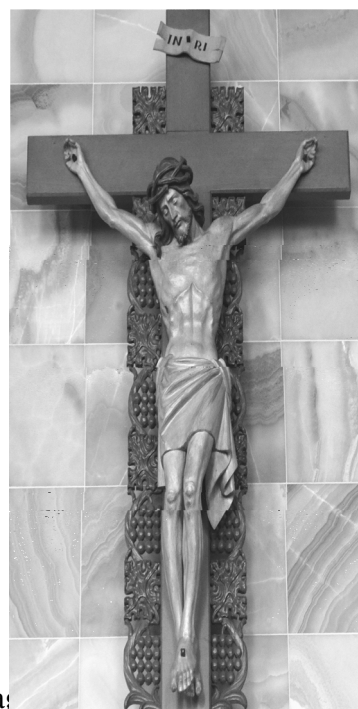

Staying Informed: The Diaper Bank and Church Statuary

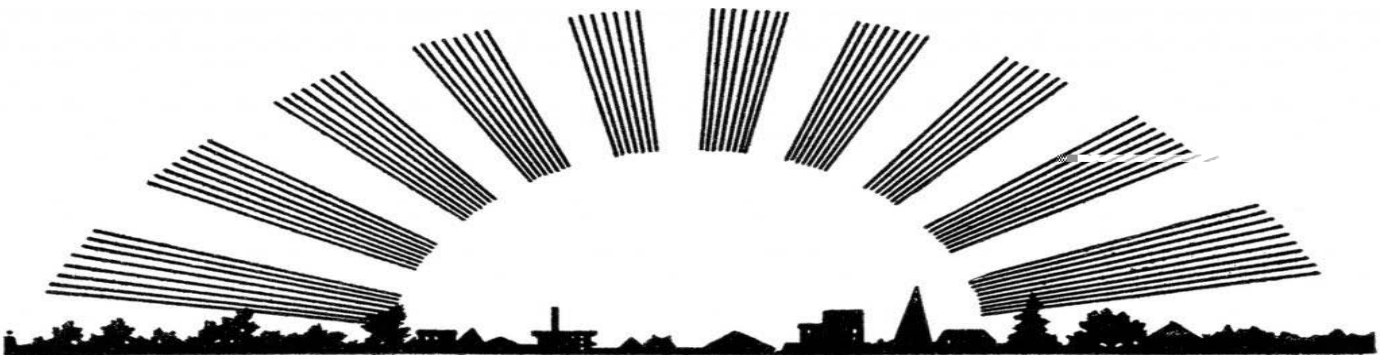
In an effort to keep us all knowledgeable and up-to-date with the latest information about our future, this column will appear each week.

SALE OF THE PARISH AS OF OCT. 15: The 10-acres of the Our Lady of Victory property, including the rectory, church, school and convent, has been listed for sale at \$1.85 million.

THE DIAPER BANK: Barbara Messina has been working with the New Life Evangelical Free Church to transition the Diaper Bank to their premises at 255 Jones Hill Road. This is the church located on the corner of South St. and Jones Hill Road. “We will continue to hold drives in our parish to support the Diaper Bank,” said Fr. Dillon. “New Life will collect and distribute the diapers from that location, however.”

THE STATUES, CRUCIFIX, AND STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Fr. Dillon also reports that crucifix from over the altar, all statuary, altar candlesticks and the Stations of the Cross will be moving with us to our new location on Captain Thomas Boulevard. “We will be using both existing items that we will be bringing with us; changing them in and out during different liturgical seasons and for other occasions,” he said.

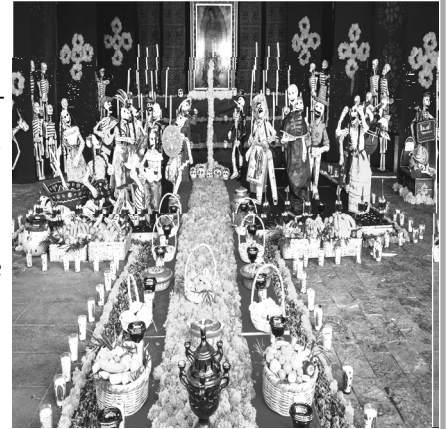

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Fridays Solemnity of All Saints and Saturdays Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed fit well at the beginning of November. The liturgical readings of this final month in the Church year are keyed to the end of time and the fulfillment of Jesus saving acts. Nowhere is this more fully celebrated than in Mexico, where November 2 is the Day of the Dead. Missionaries moved an ancient Aztec festival from midsummer to November, linking the festival to Christian themes. Today, it is a time for remembering the dead and celebrating the continuity of life, principally by festive picnics in cemeteries. There are special foods and games, and people socialize with other families and tell favorite stories about their dear ones. The sweetness of life is honored by sugary desserts and treats. Flowers, music, lights, and feasting assure that the day is not at all morbid. Traditionally, the day begins with Mass, a procession to the cemetery, and a morning feast. Most families have a special dinner with the pan de muerto, or bread of the dead. A toy skeleton is baked into the loaf, and the one who bites into it is considered lucky indeed. The dead are not feared, but deeply loved, and this joyful family feast points both to age-old customs and Resurrection faith.

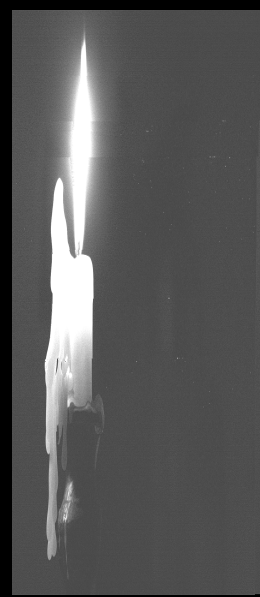

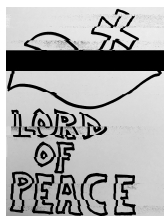

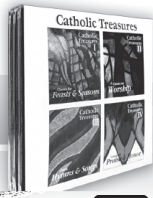
