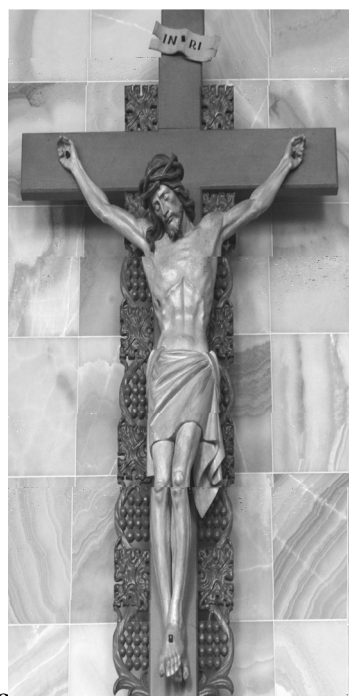

Staying Informed: Stained Glass Windows

In an effort to keep us all knowledgeable and up-to-date with the latest information about our future, this column will appear each week.

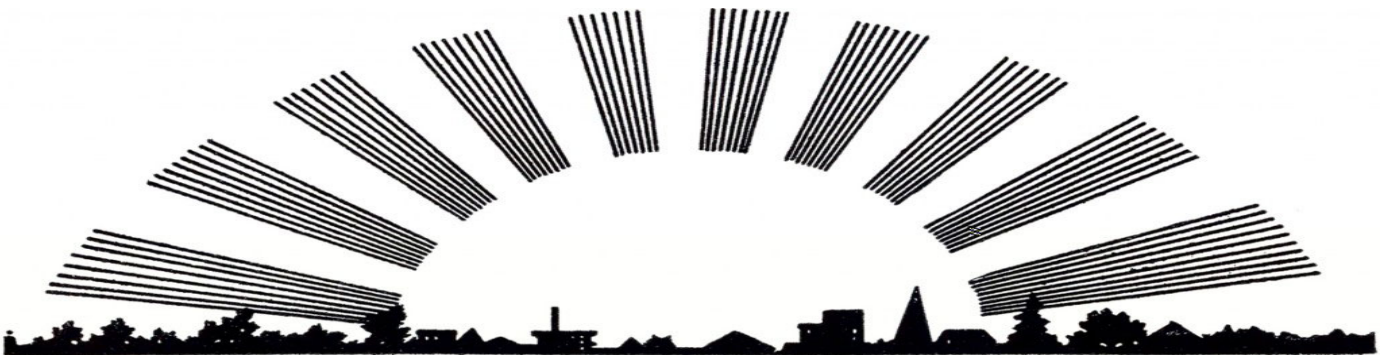
THE PROCESS OF SELLING THE PROPERTY AS OF OCT. 29: The 10-acres of the Our Lady of Victory property, including the rectory, church, school and convent, has been listed for sale at \$1.85 million. According to Fr. Dillon, there have been multiple showings by our realtor.

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS: Archdiocesan regulations and Canon Law dictate what from a closing church can be saved, relocated or sold. Fr. Dillon says the Archdiocese will relocate the stained glass windows to another church or chapel or consign them with a national supplier who will find a fitting home for them. In future bulletins, we will list other items from the church that will be relocated, sold or redistributed according to the proper Church guidelines.

WHY ARE MASSES BEING BOOKED THROUGH JUNE ONLY? “The Archdiocese has asked all parishes to book Masses six months at a time,” said Fr. Dillon. During the transition of selling the property at 600-634 Jones Hill Road and preparing our new location at 300 Captain Thomas Boulevard, all aspects of our Parish life will be reviewed, including the Mass schedule, which also may affect booking Mass intentions. Watch the bulletin for updates on booking Masses as we move through the new year.

THE DIAPER BANK: Barbara Messina has been working with the New Life Evangelical Free Church to transition the Diaper Bank to their premises at 255 Jones Hill Road. This is the church located on the corner of South St. and Jones Hill Road. “We will continue to hold drives in our parish to support the Diaper Bank,” said Fr. Dillon. “New Life will collect and distribute the diapers from that location, however.”

THE STATUES, CRUCIFIX, AND STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Fr. Dillon also reports that crucifix from over the altar, all statuary, altar candlesticks and the Stations of the Cross will be moving with us to our new location on Captain Thomas Boulevard. “We will be using both existing items and items that we will be bring with us; changing them in and out during different liturgical seasons and for other occasions,” he said.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Every week, some treasures from our tradition are shared here. Where does all this history come from? The history of God's people of prayer is always coming to light, mostly because scholars have dedicated their lives to research. They translate and ponder prayers and songs; explore the places used for worship; look at the vessels, books, and vestments; and read works from legal documents to letters and diaries. In the 1930s, Hitler's rush to arm Germany closed seminaries as priests and seminarians alike were drafted into service.

One professor, Father Josef Jungman, forced from his classroom, spent the war years in an Austrian library. His careful work disclosed much of what we know of the history of the Mass. His great work, *The Mass of the Roman Rite*, describes the evolution of Eucharistic celebration and inspired generations of scholars to explore a tradition surprisingly rich and varied. It was said of him that he had a command of the past that cast new light on the present, and opened up a clear direction to the future. His contributions to the Second Vatican Council helped shape the way that we worship today. At the end of his life, in 1975, his studies completed, he told a friend that he was waiting patiently for the Lord's knock at the door to take him to the heavenly banquet.

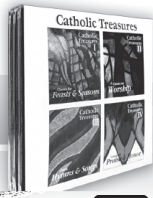
