Staying Informed: Our Future

Staying Informed: The Ministries of the Beacon on the Hill

“We are not living in an era of change, but a change of era.” – Pope Francis

In an effort to keep us all knowledgeable and up-to-date with the latest information about our future, this column will appear each week.

THE PROCESS OF SELLING THE PROPERTY AS OF NOV. 19: The 10-acres of the Our Lady of Victory property, including the rectory, church, school and convent, has been listed for sale at \$1.85 million. According to Fr. Dillon, there have been multiple showings by our realtor.

THE CLOTHES CLOSET: In preparation for the sale of the property up on the hill at 634 Jones Hill Road, co-directors Roseann Gulisano and Barbara Messina have been working hard to relocate the individual services offered by the Beacon on the Hill, our community outreach center. “This is giving our parish the opportunity to do something with West Haven’s interfaith community,” said Roseann, “And we are so happy it is working out that way.”

The Clothes Closet, its clothing and racks are moving to The Vertical Church, 225 Meloy Road. “We are so pleased that they are taking this on in its entirety,” said Barbara. The Clothes Closet is expected to be closed by the end of the year. In 2020, please continue to support this ministry by bringing your clothing donations to The Vertical Church.

“Most importantly,” said Roseann, “we want to continue to serve the population we currently serve. We do not want these families to go without the things they need most. Having these other churches so close to us come forward helps the mission of the Beacon to continue.”

Fr. Dillon says that as a parish family we will continue to support those in need in our community. He said to watch for the Giving Tree during Advent, upcoming holiday food drives and diaper drives to continue throughout the year.

FOOD PANTRY AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENT CLOSET: Space restrictions at our new location on Captain Thomas Boulevard will also require us to discontinue our Food Pantry and Medical Equipment collections. W.H.E.A.T. will be the recipient of any food we have stored at the end of the year. We are currently reaching out to other area churches who have space available for storing medical equipment, which takes up a lot of room.

THE DIAPER BANK: Barbara Messina has been working with the New Life Evangelical Free Church to transition the Diaper Bank to their premises at 255 Jones Hill Road. This is the church located on the corner of South St. and Jones Hill Road.

“I’m really going to miss having all of these services under one roof,” said Roseann, “but I’m happy that our parishioners can continue to support those in need by donating to these nearby houses of faith. Our volunteers have done a phenomenal job over the years,” said Roseann. “And I’m happy to hear that some of these angels will continue to volunteer at the new locations.”

Following Mary’s Pregnancy

Mary is three weeks away from giving birth. Today, in the 21st century, in the U.S.A., the shower would have been thrown. The crib and changing table put into a freshly painted room. Framed sonogram pictures complete with a monogrammed name would have been given to family and friends. None of that would have been done in the first century. The presumption that mother and child would make it through the nine months, much less child-birth simply did not exist in the first century. The mortality rate for mothers and babies was extremely high, up until even just a hundred years ago. So the joy when a child made it through the first week to be named and circumcised on the 8th day was shared by the whole communi-ty!

In this time in the USA, it is almost guaranteed that mother and child will come sailing through both the pregnancy and the childbirth. There is every expectation that should any problems arise, medical science will see this child through. As such, we have lost that sense of joy today. Not only do we as a community, not celebrate the birth of every child. We allow and even encourage moth-ers to end the life of their child at any point during the 40 weeks of pregnancy. And even after a healthy baby has been born. As we think of the baby Jesus, let us pray for all those babies at risk of not being born.

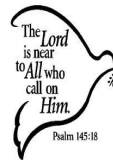


The 2020 Mass Book is Open to 6/30/20

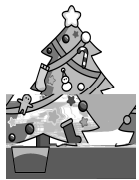

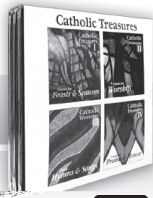
